


How to use our loop labels correctly




Wrong!

The end of the loop must not run over the perforation of the label, otherwise the reset force will increase. This separates the two adhesive surfaces from each other again and the label opens. If the loop is too long, simply shorten it with scissors before gluing.




Correct!

The tip of the loop is glued into the back of the adjoining labelling field right behind the end of the loop, but with sufficient clearance of the loop for the jewellery.



Wrong!

The loop must not be placed too tightly around the jewellery, otherwise the resulting tensile stress will release the bond and the label will open again. Especially with broad rings it is better to use a label with a longer loop.



Our Tip!

The loop should be long enough to allow the label to move without tension. In addition, always press the label surfaces firmly together when applying the label. This strengthens the adhesive power and thus the closure of the label.
